- Assisting in the routine upkeep of our dinghy fleet
- Offering help and guidance to members to better enjoy sailing
- Being the "public face" of the club when dealing with the general public

This position will be of interest to instructors with

- Certified CANSail instructor qualifications (i.e., CANSail 1/2, 3/4, 5/6)
- Membership in good standing with Sail Canada
- Ability to work throughout the spring and summer (e.g., part time May June, full time July and August)
- Previous coaching experience, preferably in a lead role
- Strong leadership, organizational, sail programming and planning skills
- Strong communication and team relationship skills
- Previous experience working with adults and youth
- Experience sailing and teaching in a variety of boats

- A current Police Check Vulnerable Sector Screening
- A Pleasure Craft Operators Card with experience driving a motor boat

The salary is \$22-26/hour, depending on candidate qualifications.

The position offers part time employment from mid May to late June and full time employment (40+ hours/week) from late June through late August.

The schedule includes evening work one night/week during July and August.
